





- Registry of identifier for researchers (3.4M of them!)
- Standard procedures connecting researchers to affiliations & activities
- Committed community building connectors

ORCID AS SERVICE PROVIDER

- 25,000 SSO users from 724 IdPs
- Recommendations for ORCID
 - User Interface
 - Account handling when IdP access is disconnected
- Recommendations for IdPs
 - Socialize benefits of ORCID
 - Become an ORCID-enabled IdP









ORCID-ENABLED IDP

- Individual uses SSO to sign into ORCID
- Provides institution permission to update ORCID record
- Institution asserts affiliation on the ORCID record
- Affiliation assertion available to funders, publishers, associations, repositories, etc







ORCID AS AN IDENTITY PROVIDER

- Used as social identity
- Recommendations for ORCID
 - Add two-factor authentication
 - ORCID as strong self-service identity vetting
 - ORCID as an attribute provider


