Since 2016 SWAMID <https://www.sunet.se/services/identifying/swamids> metadata [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/SAML\\_metadata](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/SAML_metadata) has been signed with a key in a HSM [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Hardware\\_security\\_module](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Hardware_security_module). This has been fine since we previously only were creating a handful of metadata aggregation files <https://mds.swamid.se/md/> (of different sizes). The problem with the aggregated feeds is that it takes time and memory(!) to load an in SWAMID's case 80 MB XML <https://en.wikipedia.org/>....
